REGULATIONS

- 1. JURISDICTION:** The assessment and track day will be held under the general Competition Rules and Standing Regulations of the MCUI and the Motor Cycle Union of Ireland Southern Centre Ltd, and any further supplementary regulations that may be issued.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY:** Open to 2025 Newcomers MCUI Licence applicants.
- 3. STEWARDS OF THE MEETING:** M.C.I.

- 5. CLASSES:**

1) Solo Rider / Sidecar Driver €150	2) Sidecar Passenger €50
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- 6. TRANSPONDERS:** There will be no timekeeping at this event. No Transponders Required.
- 7. ENTRIES:** Entries must be made on the official entry form, completed in every detail, signed and accompanied by the full entry fee. Unpaid entries will be returned to sender. The MCI reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason. **No Refunds after 30th January 2025.**
- 8. HIGH VIS VESTS:** **ALL Newcomers MUST wear a high vis vest (orange) whilst on track at any time during their first year of racing including this assessment day.**
- 9. COURSE:** The event will be held on the MONDELLO PARK National CIRCUIT, which measures approximately 1.2 Miles per lap and is ridden CLOCKWISE.
- 10. TOURING:** Touring on the circuit during assessment is not permitted. Drivers must not drive or push their machines in the reverse direction of the course, unless under the instruction of an official.
- 11. EVENT:** SATURDAY 1st Feb 2025: Sign on will commence at 9:15am. Classroom start at 9:30am. Finish approx. 3pm
SATURDAY 22nd Feb 2025: Sign on will commence at 8.30am. Technical inspection 9am. Track sessions will start at 10:00am. Finish approx. 3pm.
- 12. PROHIBITION OF WHEELING:** The deliberate lifting of the front wheel for the purpose of showmanship is strictly forbidden and may result in the exclusion of the offender from the event. Any other action that could reasonably be interpreted as showmanship or unsafe behaviour shall carry the same penalty.
- 13. IDENTITY DISCS:** An identification Disc/SOS card must be worn during the track assessment.
- 14. DOGS:** Dogs are **NOT** permitted at the circuit.
- 15. OFFICIAL INSTRUCTIONS:** A fine may be imposed by the Stewards, or the MCI, on a driver/rider, assistant, mechanic or passenger who does not comply with the requirements, of the supplementary regulations, or the official instructions. A fine imposed by the Stewards of the meeting shall be limited to €130.
- 16. FUEL:** All fuels must be stored in metal containers and comply with M.C.U.I Rules.
- 17. PUSH STARTS:** Anyone wishing to push start a machine for any reason in the paddock area, must only do so in the area designated. For Mondello Park, this area shall be fenced off paddock warming up area.
- 18. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS:** All competitors' vehicles must carry a fire extinguisher; the recommended type is a 2 kilogram extinguisher.
- 19. PADDOCK TRANSPORT:** In the interests of safety in all areas of the circuit, the use of mini-bikes or other paddock motorcycles/bicycles/scooters used for transport are not permitted. This also applies to children using such machines. Riders are reminded that they are responsible for the actions of their team and family in this regard and may face sanction as a direct result of their actions. Riders should not ride race motorcycles through the paddock area.
- 20. ALCOHOL:** Random breath tests may take place. The permitted level of Alcohol is 0.1

As a Competitor in this event I make this acknowledgement and acceptance of risk and waiver of my legal rights for the benefit of **Motor Cycling Ireland** which in this agreement means the company Motor Cycle Union of Ireland (Southern Centre) Limited, its officers, staff, volunteers, race officials, emergency responders, servants and agents or any of the aforementioned persons.

I **Acknowledge** that I am voluntarily and willingly accepting and assuming the risk that as a competitor I may suffer injury, death, loss or damage and I comprehend the nature and extent of those risks.

I **Waive**, to the full extent permitted by law, any claim I may have as a competitor against **Motor Cycling Ireland** in respect of any injury, death, loss or damage suffered, howsoever caused.

I confirm that this **Acknowledgement & Waiver** can be relied upon in the defence of any action brought by me or my successors or assigns or surviving dependants against **Motor Cycling Ireland**, as defined above.
I acknowledge that motor cycling events are very dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury, death, loss or damage including property damage and that the actions and failures of **Motor Cycling Ireland**, as defined above, can cause or contribute to accidents and injury.

I am aware that the design and condition of an event site and the state of the premises, including the race course and competitors paddocks, can also cause or contribute to accidents and injury to competitors.

I confirm that my decision to compete on the day of an event will be made after I have satisfied myself as to the following matters;

- (a) The suitability and condition of my vehicle and protective equipment.
- (b) That I have the appropriate knowledge, experience and skill to compete in the events for which I have been entered.
- (c) The design, lay-out and condition of the race course.
- (d) The weather conditions.
- (e) That I am familiar with the current rules and regulations governing the event.

I confirm that I am aware that I can on the day of an event withdraw from entering an event or retire from an event in progress.

I confirm that I was given, and I understand, final instructions either in writing or as a riders briefing

I consent to details of any injuries I may suffer at this event being passed between all medical services and the Clerk of the Course/ Secretary of the Meeting

- Newcomers to Short Circuit racing must complete MCI Training Course and Exam, classroom course on 1st February and Track assessment on 22nd February.
- Short Circuit riders who have not held a competition licence / competed within the last 4 years must complete MCI Training Course and Exam, classroom course on 1st February and Track assessment on 22nd February.
- Road bikes are not allowed. Must be Race / Track Bike.
- All applicants must send their Assessment Day Application Form, completed in every detail, ***Signed*** to Shortcircuitnewcomers@motorcyclingireland.ie
This must be received before 5pm 29th January 2025.
- Saturday 1st February will consist of a classroom course only (Bike not Required). Classroom session will include in person Flag Seminar.
- Saturday 22nd February will consist of track time and assessment.(Race/Track bike required)
- Applicants must complete a self-medical (top section of medical form only) in order to participate in Track Assessment.
